## Winter/Spring Clay Classes

This winter we'll offer a 12-week class, using the wheel to throw pots which, combined, will result in covered jars, mugs with lids, dip plates, creamer and sugar sets. We will handbuild handles, lugs and knobs—maybe even frogs for the bottom of mugs or top of jars.

Class will be on Wednesday nights, 6-9 p.m., and will continue for 12 weeks, long enough to hone skills and for the snow to melt so we can get to the kiln to fire in March. (There will be a subsequent 8-week spring class in April-May.) We will not offer a children's class this winter, as I will be involved in school residencies in Tilton and Rye.

All skill levels are welcome, as the class will be kept small and will allow for lots of personal attention. (If there is enough interest, we will add a Tuesday class, but Wednesday is a definite.) Tuition is \$480 for the 12-week winter class, and \$320 for the 8-week spring class. There will be a small charge for supplies based on student usage.

Class begins Wednesday January 11. We request a \$50 nonrefundable deposit to hold your place, and the balance when class begins. (If you prefer to pay in two installments, let us know.) Not already a student here? Please call for more information before a decision is made.

Clay is an essential material, one that is challenging and satisfying to work with. Nothing is more local than making your own vessels.
